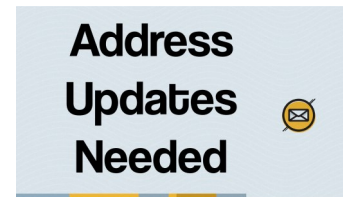
## COMING UP...
