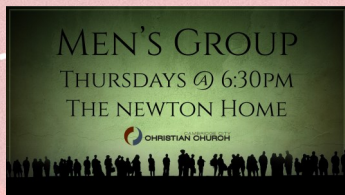
The Church Office will be closed from December 25th to January 1st. In case of emergency, please contact a church staff member.
