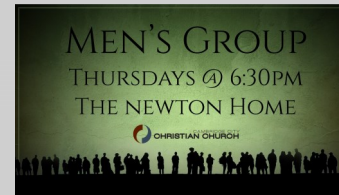
COMING UP..
